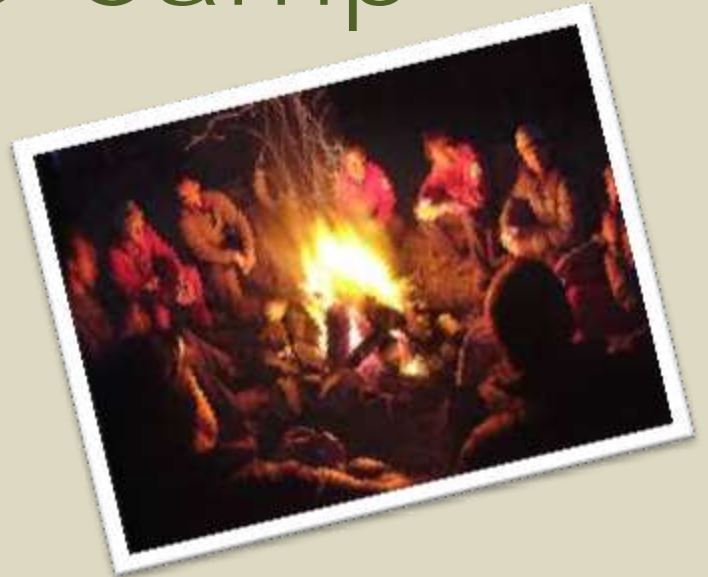

Polaris – 20-21 September (tutor groups L and O)

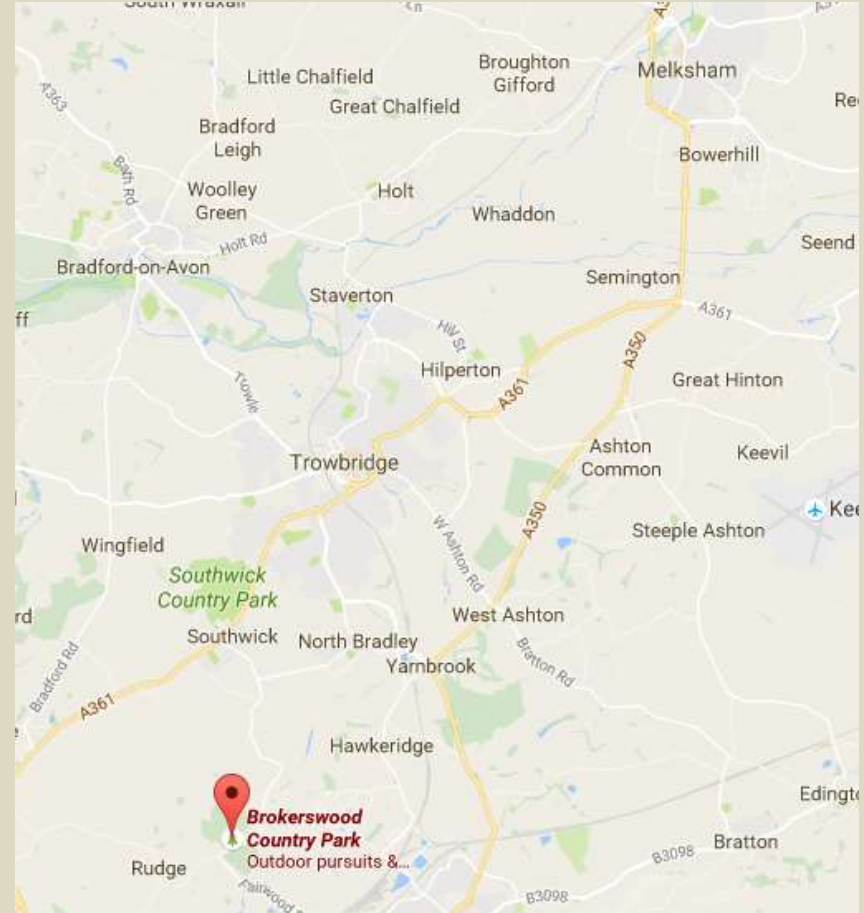
Omega – 25-26 September (tutor groups E and H)

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Where?



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Brokers Wood

- Secure Camp site, 20 minute drive from school
- Access to toilets and washing area
- Students will have access to water to wash hands & face and brush teeth
- Staff levels are 1 adult to 10 children and this is the same day or night.
- Staff tents are situated between the boys side and girls side.
- At least one member of staff is a trained first aider

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Itinerary

Day1:

- 8.30 – bring bags to school; drop bags in designated area; hand over medication to me
- 8.40- 9.00 – tutor time
- 9.15 – catch bus to Brokers Wood
- 10.00-18.15 – 4 x Activities

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Please DO.....

- Be upbeat about the trip with your child. For some this will be the first time they have stayed away from home and your upbeat positive attitude will rub off on your child.
- Ensure your child has had a good breakfast on the day that they leave.
- Send your child's equipment in a sensible bag. They will be in charge of carrying their own sleeping bag and kit from the bus to the campsite.
- Pack a torch for your child. There are no floodlights at the campsite and a torch is essential for 'finding your way' after dark.
- Pack some Marshmallows! This is the only item of food we would ask you to provide. We will be toasting these by campfire.

Write your child's name on EVERYTHING. This helps avoid upset when things get lost

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Please don't.....

- Allow your child to bring bags of sweets. We will provide meals and snacks throughout the trip.
- Allow your child to bring mobile phones. We have a school mobile to make any calls needed.
- If your child brings any of the valuables listed above they do so at their own risk. The school will not accept responsibility for loss or damage.
- Ask your child to ring home.

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Kit List

- Roll Mat; Pillow
- Sleeping Bag
- Waterproof Jacket
- Trainers/walking boots for walking around camp
- Set of clothes and shoes for canoeing – these will probably get wet!
- Other clothes for wearing around camp
- Torch
- Warm hat
- Sun hat
- Warm jumpers
- Bed clothes
- Underwear/socks

- Knife, fork, spoon
- Plate/bowl; Plastic cup/mug – labelled please
- Water bottle – labelled please
- Towel
- Sun Cream
- Wash kit
- Medication – should be labelled and handed over to me
- Food: packed lunch for day 1
- Cakes for the group (optional)
